

Summary of Delta Fish Actions in WY 2001

December 2000

- 22 DCC gates closed
- 27 DCC gates opened

January 2001

- 9 – 11 Requested exports at 3000 cfs for 3-day radio-tagged salmon study in south Delta - exports were at this level due to water quality considerations
- 14 DCC gates closed
- 17 - 21 Exports to 6000 cfs for 5 days, planned exports were 8000-9200 cfs, but baseline exports may have been reduced from that level due to water quality
- 18 - 20 Exports to 3000 cfs for 3-day radio-tagged salmon study in south Delta; within 5-day period at 6000 cfs described above
- 23 DCC gates opened
- 26 DCC gates closed - gates remain closed through Jan 31
- 27 – 31 Exports to 6000 cfs, reduced from planned exports of 11,600 - 11,900 cfs, for 5 days but conditions re-evaluated on Jan 29; decision then was to continue at 6000 cfs for the 4th and 5th days.

February 2001

- 1 DCC gates closed until May 20.
- 1 - 5 Exports to 8000 cfs, reduced from planned exports of about 10,500 - 11,000 cfs initially, baseline exports perhaps declining over time.
- 16 – 22 Exports to 7,000 cfs, reduced from 9,000 - 9,500 cfs initially, baseline exports perhaps increasing over time.
